

Line Drawing - Plants

You will be assessed on...

- Accuracy of representation.
- Tonal range.
- Neatness.
- Range of texture.

- The first drawing exercise is designed to help encourage using the pencil with skill and subtlety.
- You will work carefully using a very sharp pencil. This will allow you to capture a great deal of detail.



- Carefully sketch out your composition on a piece of A4 paper.
- Fill the page.
- Use light lines first.
- You can vary the thickness of your line for effect but don't shade anything at this point.



- Work from the top left down to the bottom right of your picture so you don't smudge your work.
- Use a sharp HB pencil, softer pencils will smudge and make a mess of your work.
- Give the leaves in the background less of a tonal range than the ones in the foreground.
 - This will make them appear slightly blurred and add depth to your picture.
